

This data privacy policy (hereinafter referred as “policy”) clarifies the type, scope and purpose of the processing of personal data within our website, www.riskadapt.eu, functions and contents connected with it (hereinafter referred to as “website”).

RISKADAPT is a project funded by the European Union.

WHO WE ARE

For the processing of your personal data controller is the RISKADAPT Horizon Europe project coordinator, the RISA Sicherheitsanalysen GmbH, based in Berlin, Germany on behalf of the RISKADAPT Horizon Europe project consortium.

DEFINITIONS

The terms used refer to the definitions in Article 4 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR):

“personal data” means any information, such as name, address, email, phone number etc., relating to an identified or identifiable natural person (‘data subject’), visitor / user of the website.

“processing” means any operation or set of operations which is performed on personal data or on sets of personal data, whether or not by automated means, such as collection, recording, organisation, structuring, storage, adaptation or alteration, retrieval, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination or otherwise making available, alignment or combination, restriction, erasure or destruction. Processing includes any operation performed by the controller on personal data of the visitors / users of the website.

Information we collect

We collect your information either directly from you or automatically through our website.

We encourage you to provide only information that is necessary for the use of our website, in order to help you protect yourself and your information.

We collect information under the following circumstances:

When visiting the RISKADAPT website – The IT systems and applications designated for the operation of this Website detect, during the course of their ordinary operation, certain data – the transmission of which is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols – not associated with directly identifiable users.

When you contact us via email or filling the contact form — for example, when you ask for support, send us questions or comments, or report a problem, we collect your name, your email address, your message, etc. We use those data only to answer the queries we receive.

Usage data — when you visit our site, we store the website address you visited us from, the pages of our site you visit, the date and duration of your visit, your anonymised IP address, information from the

device (device type, operating system, screen resolution, language, country you are located in and web browser type) you used during your visit.

When you register to receive news — we use Mailchimp as a service to create and distribute the RISKADAPT project newsletters as well as manage subscriptions. The personal data that we collect are: your email address, your first and last name.

We process only the necessary data in order to provide you with the content you registered for.

If you send an email or provide an email address to info@riskadapt.eu for any reason, we reserve the right to retain that email address to use to send future notifications in accordance with this Privacy Policy.

USE OF YOUR INFORMATION

We may use information that we collect about you, including personal information, to:

Inform you about RISKADAPT advances. Share news, press releases, pilot-related campaigns and activities, results, launch of technologies and other material relevant to our outreach and impact creation activities (eg. newsletters, communication and informational material).

Invite you to RISKADAPT project events and campaigns. Share invitations on project events and pilot/awareness campaigns for participation or performing a speech, or take part in any way relevant to the project objectives and pursuits.

Respond to your requests. We may also use your information to respond to your questions or comments.

Protect our rights and interests as well as the rights and interests of our users and any other person, as well as to enforce this Private Policy.

Comply with applicable legal or regulatory obligations, including informal requests from law enforcement or other governmental authorities.

Perform functions as otherwise described to you at the time of collection.

COOKIES

We use Cookies to track the activity on our Service and store certain information.

Cookies or Browser Cookies. A cookie is a small file placed on your device. You can instruct your browser to refuse all Cookies or to indicate when a Cookie is being sent.
